What is your favorite drink? "Iced tea – Rum & Coke"


Tell us a little about your family? "My wife Shirley also lives Howard Rettenmeier

EGG CASSEROLE FOR TWO

INGREDIENTS

3eggs

3 tablespoons milk

2 slices white bread, cut into 1-inch cubes

1 green onion, with top thinly sliced

1/3 cup shredded cheddar cheese

1/3 cup chopped ham



DIRECTIONS

Preheat oven to 350 degrees.

Spray small 2-cup capacity oval baker with vegetable spray.

In bowl, combine eggs, milk, bread, green onion, cheese and ham; mix well.

Pour egg mixture into baker.

Bake in oven for 20-25 minutes or until egg mixture is set.
