
Getting to know Dick Aitchison

What is a fun fact about you? "I've spent many winters in Mesa, Arizona. I have a house there, and it's one of my favorite





Broccoli Salad

Ingredients

8 cups of broccoli florets cut into bite-sized pieces

1/3 cup diced red onion

1/2 cup dried cranberries

1/4 cup sunflower seeds

1/2 cup bacon bits or chopped bacon

Dressing

1 cup mayonnaise

3 tablespoons apple cider vinegar

2 tablespoons granulated sugar

Salt and pepper to taste



Instructions

Whisk together dressing ingredients in a medium bowl and set aside. In a large bowl combine broccoli, onion, cranberries, sunflower seeds, and bacon. Pour the dressing over and mix well. Refrigerate for at least one hour before serving.
